

Committee shall return to this Court a full and particular account of the same, with an affidavit of the truth thereof, and of the fairness of such sale, annexed, and on the ratification of such sale by the Court, and on the payment of the whole purchase money for the real estate, and not before, the said Committee by a good and sufficient deed to be executed and acknowledged agreeably to law, shall convey to the purchaser or purchasers of said real estate, the property to him, her or them sold; and the said Committee shall bring into this Court the money arising on such sale, and the bonds or notes which may be taken for the same, to be disposed of under the direction of this Court, after deducting therefrom the costs of this proceeding and such commission to the said Committee as the Court shall think proper to allow, in consideration of the skill, attention and fidelity wherewith she shall have appeared to have discharged her trust.
