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Forty-eight Cents (\$17.48) including taxes, interest and costs, necessary to redeem the property as aforesaid has not been paid, and the property, therefore, has not been redeemed, and that more than one year from the date of sale has passed; all of which is more particularly shown on the Certificate of Redemption issued by the Treasurer of Frederick County and filed herewith and marked "Exhibit B" and prayed to be taken as a part of this Petition.

TO THE END THEREFORE:

1. That a final decree shall be passed foreclosing all rights of redemption of the Defendants in and to the property assessed to Henry Howard Ahalt in Middletown District, Frederick County, Maryland.

2. And for such other and further relief as the nature of their case may require.

And your Petitioner further prays that an Order of Publication may be passed by your Honorable Court to be published in some newspaper in Frederick County, giving notice to the non-resident Defendants, H. Earl Ahalt and Helen M. Ahalt, his wife, who reside at 50 South Royal Street, York, Pennsylvania, and to all other persons having or claiming to have any interest in the property, commanding them to be and appear in your Honorable Court in person or by solicitor on some certain date to be named therein, and show cause, if any they have, why the relief prayed for should not be granted.
