

Yarroll, County Treasurer, Frederick County, Maryland the sum of \$16.50, representing unpaid taxes and interest ; that the said Mary A. Williner was the successful bidder of said property; that there is filed herewith, a statement of Charbttte W. Yarroll, County Treasurer as aforesaid, showing the amount necessary for redemption of said property, which said statement is filed herewith marked Plaintiff's Exhibit #2 and prayed to be considered a part hereof; and that the said property has not been redeemed by any party in interest, although more than one year from the date of sale has expired, and that the amount necessary for the redemption of said lot or parcel of land is \$16.50, which your petitioner is entitled to be reimbursed.

Wherefore, Your Petitioner Prays:

1. That a final decree may be passed by Your Honorable Court foreclosing all rights of redemption of the defendants herein, in and to the property hereinbefore set forth, and that the County Treasurer of Frederick County, Md., be directed to prepare and execute a deed in fee simple for said herein described real estate unto the complainant herein, upon the payment by her of the purchase price of the property herein described, together with all taxes, interest and penalties thereon accruing prior to the date of said sale.

2. And for such other and further relief as the nature of her case may require.

May it please your Honors to grant unto your Petitioner, the State's Write of Subpoena directed to Mary A. Williner, divorced, 729 Gallatin St., N.W. Wash., D.C., and also grant unto your petitioner, an order of publication directed to the said defendant, Homer W. Williner, who is a non-resident of the State of Maryland, and all other persons having or claiming to have, whether resident or non resident of the State of Maryland, any interest in the property mentioned in paragraph No. 1 of this Bill of Complaint, notifying them and demanding them and each of them to appear in this court on or before a certain day to be named therein, not less than 60 days from the date of the filing of this Bill & to answer said Bill or to redeem said property, and warning them upon their failure to do so a final decree will be passed foreclosing all rights of redemption in the said property, and also that a writ of subpoena be issued to the County Treasurer, demanding her to be and appear in this court, in person or by
