ORDER OF PUBLICATION

The object of this proceeding is to secure the foreclosure of all rights of redemption in the following property located in Middletown Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, fronting 93-1/2 feet on the South side of Potomac Avenue, Braddock Heights, Maryland, with an even depth of 200 feet, as described in a deed from J. Fred Main and Annie C. Main, his wife, unto Homer E. Williner and Mary A. Williner, his wife, dated November 1, 1943, and recorded in Liber 439, folio 519, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, sold by the Collector of Taxes for the County of Frederick and the State of Maryland, to the plaintiff in this proceeding, to-wit:

The Bill of Complaint states, among other things, that the amounts necessary for the redemption of said lot or parcel of land has not been paid, although more than a year and a day from the date of sale has expired.
