3rd. That the land mentioned in the first paragraph in this Bill of Complaint and fully described in Exhibit A. filed herewith, is not susceptible of division among the parties thereunto entitled without loss and injury, and the same should therefore be sold and the proceeds thereof divided among the parties thereunto entitled according to their respective rights and interests.

TO THE END, THEREFORE, (a) That the said real estate may be sold and the proceeds thereof divided among the parties thereunto entitled.

(b) That your Complainants may have such other and further relief as the nature and equity of their case may require.

May It Please Your Honors to grant unto your Complainants the writ of subpoena directed to the Sheriff of Frederick County against the said Julia E. Hummer and Joseph H. Hummer, her husband, Dorothy M. C. Stull and Sylvester N. Stull, her husband, who reside in Frederick County, Maryland, commanding them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some day certain to be named therein, to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed herein; and that an order of publication may be passed by your Honorable Court giving notice to the said non-resident, infant Defendants, John M. Miller, Effie Miller and Harvey E. Miller, of the substance, object and purpose of the bill of complaint in this cause filed, and warning them and each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court either in person or by solicitor on some day certain to be named therein, to answer the premises and
