Q. State your name, age and place of residence?

Q. Is your mother, Julia A. Miller, living or dead, and if dead when did she die?

A. She is dead, she died on January 21st, 1910.

A. John W. L. Miller, a son, who is unmarried; Mary C. E. Haines, a daughter, whose husband's name is Andrew Haines; Julia E. Hummer, a daughter, whose husband's name is Joseph H. Hummer; C. Hicks Miller, a son, whose wife's name is Laura Miller; Franklin N. Miller, a son, whose wife's name is Franzina Miller; Edward W. Miller, a son, whose wife's name is Cora B. Miller; Dorothy M. C. Stull, a daughter, whose husband's name is Sylvester F. Stull. All of the above are adults and reside in Frederick County. They are all of the children of John W. Miller and Julia A. Miller that are now living. There is a son, George T. Miller, who resided in Zenia, Ohio, and who died about thirteen years ago and who left surviving him the following three children, whose names are: John M. Miller, Effie Elizabeth Miller and Harvey Fline Miller. Of these three children, John M. Miller is an adult, having attained the age of twenty-one years on the 29th of September, 1910. Effie E.
