8. I bequeath to my nephew, Willie Gregg, the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00);

9. I bequeath to my nephew, Roscoe Gregg, the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00);

10. I bequeath to my niece, Mildred Flohr, the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00);

All the rest, residue and remainder of the proceeds from the said sale of personal property, I give and bequeath in equal shares to my brothers and sisters namely, Mrs. Annie Cecil, wife of Wilbur Cecil; My sister Lillie Cooley, wife of Nathan Cooley; my brother Ira F.
