PETITION OF SUBSTITUTED TRUSTEE TO SELL REAL ESTATE TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Talmadge N. Cecil, Substituted Trustee in the above cause, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:

FIRST: That on the 16th day of February, 1956, your Honorable Court assumed the jurisdiction of the Trust mentioned in these proceedings, and your Petitioner, as Substituted Trustee, was duly appointed and did qualify by giving his Bond and Security for the due execution of the said Trust.

THIRD: That the last surviving sister, a certain Lillie M. Cooley, there having been no surviving brothers of the said Edward C. Sears, died on the 12th day of November, 1964; that your Petitioner, in pursuance of the terms of the aforesaid Will, desires to proceed with the public sale of said real estate, making distribution and terminating the Trust as aforementioned.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays that your Honorable Court will pass an Order authorizing and directing your Petitioner, as Substituted Trustee, to
