- Q. Will you advise what you feel was a fair market value of this property at the time you appraised the same in April, 1962?
- A. \$14,000.
- Q. Would you say there has been any change in the fair market value of the property since the time of your appraisal in April, 1962?
- A. I would not want to say exactly, but I do know that real estate is not as much in demand now as it was then.
- Q. Mr. Trout, do you feel that the farm property is divisible without loss or injury to the parties to whom the same has descended?
- A. No, I do not feel it can be divided because there are 9 children in the family and it would be impossible to divide a parcel of real estate of this size equitably between the children.
- Q. Do you feel it is to the best interest of all the parties to this cause that said land be sold and after the payment of the usual court costs and expenses, the proceeds be distributed among the parties hereto in accordance with their respective interest?
- A. Yes, I do.
