The Bill prays that a Decree may be passed for the sale of said real estate by the Court and that a Trustee or Trustees may be appointed to sell the same; that the proceeds of sale may be distributed among the parties to this cause entitled thereto, after first deducting the usual costs and expenses of sale, according to their respective rights and interests; and for general relief.

It is thereupon, ORDERED, this 5th day of ^{June} ~~May~~, 1963, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, sitting as a Court of Equity, that the plaintiffs by causing a copy of this Order to be published in some newspaper, published in Frederick County, Maryland, once a week for four successive weeks, before the 20th day of July, 1963, give notice to the absent defendants of the object and substance of this Bill, warning them to be and appear in this Court in person or by solicitor, on or before the 20th day of August, 1963, to show cause, if any they may have, why a Decree should ~~not~~ be passed, as prayed.
