FIFTH: That Evelyn Wright and Elmer Wright, her husband, were served with an Equity Subpoena and a Copy of the Bill of Complaint, as evidenced by the return of the Sheriff of Baltimore County, Maryland, dated the 27th day of August, 1963; that the time limited in said Equity Subpoena has expired and that no Answers have been filed by said Respondents.

Wherefore your Petitioners prays for a Decree Pro Confesso against said Defendants.

And it is further ORDERED that testimony be taken before one of the standing Examiners of this Court in support of the allegations of said Bill of Complaint.
