5. That it is unknown to your Petitioners whether the said Anna Grace King is living or dead, and, if living, whether she is a resident or non-resident of the State of Maryland; and if the said Defendant is dead, whether any successor or successors in interest are resident or non-resident of the State of Maryland.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioners pray that your Honorable Court will pass:

- (1) An Order making the unknown heirs, devisees or personal representatives, resident or non-resident, of the said Anna Grace King, parties defendant, and
- (2) That all the said Defendants may be proceeded against as though they were non-residents of the State of Maryland, by giving notice by publication, pursuant to Rule 105 of the Maryland Rules of Procedure.
- (3) And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.
