- Q. Do you know the circumstances by which Miss King apparently broke off her relationship with the family?
- A. No. She just seemed to disappear.
- Q. Mrs. Gordon, the farm mentioned in these proceedings is now owned by yourself, the brothers which you have just named, and your nephews and nieces, children of your deceased sister, Grace, and the heirs-at-law of your deceased brother, Clarence. Will you state whether or not it is possible to divide the aforementioned farm, without loss or injury, among the parties entitled?
- A. No, it could not be so divided.
- Q. Is it your request, then, that the real estate mentioned in these proceedings be sold under the jurisdiction of Court, and the proceeds thereof divided among the several heirs?
- A. Yes.
- Q. In your opinion, what is the current fair value of the real estate involved?
- A. I am not sure, but the opinion in the community is that it should bring in the neighborhood of \$20,000.00.
