



3 That to date only Annie M. Leferre, and Luther I. Stottlemeyer and Mary Stottlemeyer, his wife, Defendants above-named, have appeared and filed their answer, consenting to the sale of the real estate described in the said proceedings, and that the remaining Defendants to said proceedings have failed to appear as required by said subpoenas, either in person or by solicitor, and consequently no demurrer, answer or other defense has been filed in these proceedings on behalf of the said Defendants.

4. That your Petitioners are desirous of making further progress toward the finality of the proceedings in the within cause.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioners pray that your Honorable Court will order that the Bill of Complaint be taken pro confesso against the said Defendants which have failed to appear and answer as aforesaid.
