 TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition and Report of Sale of Amos A. Holter, Trustee in the above entitled cause, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

1. That pursuant to the requirements of a Decree of your Honorable Court, dated the 30th day of March, 1964, the Trustee in this cause, and in said Decree named, gave bond to the State of Maryland in the penalty of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00), with personal sureties, which said bond was duly approved by the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, and filed as required by law.

2. That after giving said bond the aforesaid Trustee advertised the property hereinafter described to be sold at public sale, as will more fully appear by reference to the Printer's Certificate filed herewith as Exhibit "No. 1", and which is prayed may be taken and considered a part hereof, which said advertisement of sale was published in "The News" and "The Post", newspapers printed and circulated in Frederick County, Maryland, for more than three successive weeks prior to the day of sale, giving notice of the time, place, manner and terms of sale as required by said Decree.
