

clear and discharged of her life estate, and by said joinder does hereby expressly release her said interest in and to the aforesaid real estate and the proceeds of sale which may accrue therefrom.

(4) That the real estate hereinbefore described is not susceptible of division without loss or injury to the parties entitled thereto, and that it would be for the best interests and advantage of all the parties in interest that the said property be sold under a Decree of your Honorable Court, and that the proceeds accruing from said real estate be divided among said parties in interest according to their respective rights.

TO THE END, THEREFORE:

1. That a decree may be passed for the sale of the real estate hereinbefore described under the direction of your Honorable Court, and that the proceeds thereof may be distributed among the parties entitled, according to their respective interests.

2. And that your Complainants may have such other and further relief as the nature and equity of their case may require.

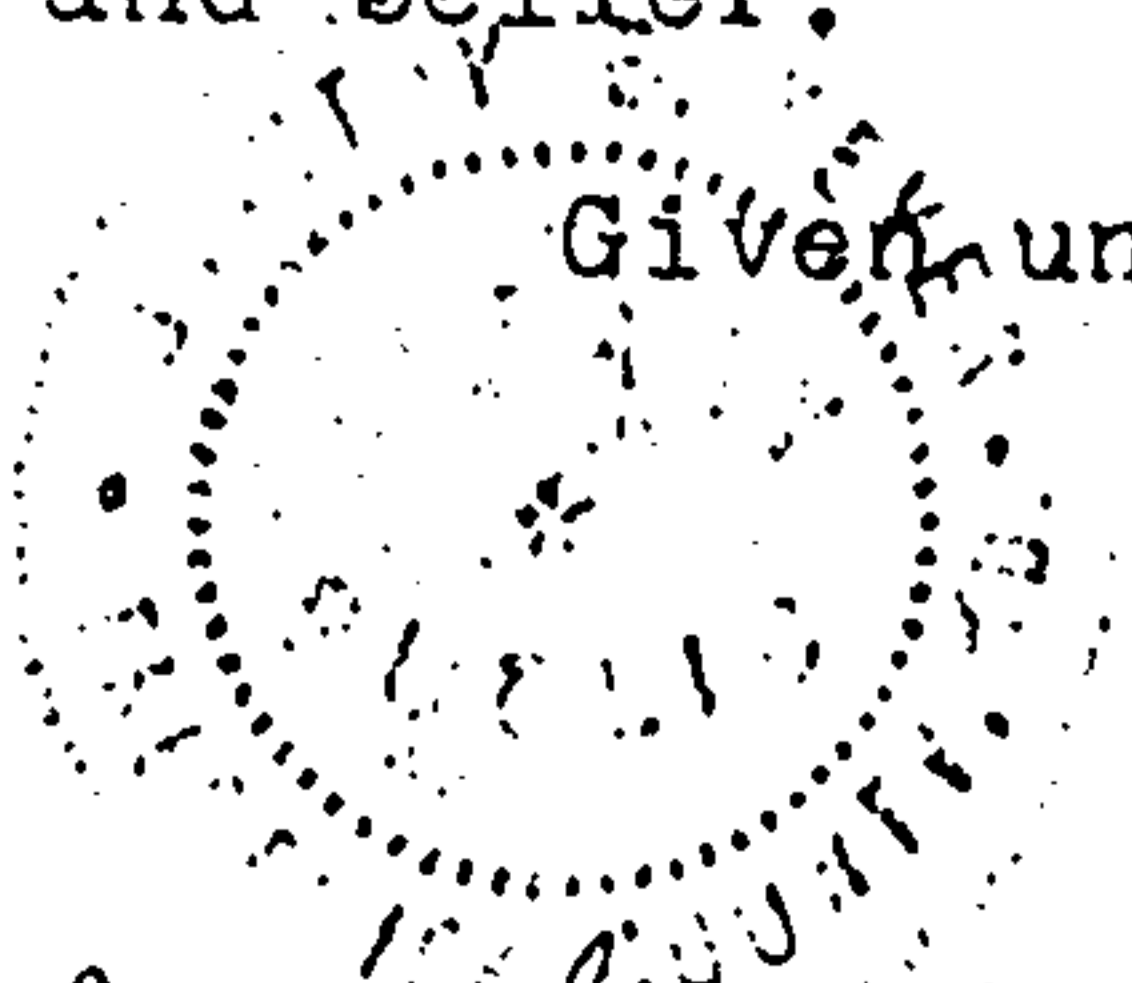
