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ORDER OF PUBLICATION

The object of this proceeding is to foreclose all rights of redemption of the Defendants in and to certain properties assessed to Roy B. Wenner in the Brunswick Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, the one containing about 9 acres of land, more or less, and located between the C & O Canal and the Potomac River and the other a lot, with improvements 100 feet by 125 feet, more or less, situate on West Potomac Street. The Bill states in substance that Charlotte W. Yarroll, County Treasurer for Frederick County, State of Maryland, offered at public auction the real estate assessed to the said Roy B. Wenner, in Brunswick Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, as aforesaid, and that said real estate is now vested in the heirs of the said Roy B. Wenner, said heirs being Roy B. Wenner, Jr., and Ellen Anderson, and any other persons having or claiming to have any interest in said property. That said sale was held on April 10, 1960, and the purchaser was Eleanor W. Wenner, (now Bissett), at the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) and Eighty Dollars (\$80) respectively. That said sale was made in satisfaction of unpaid taxes due and owing the State of Maryland, Frederick County, and the Town of Brunswick, for the year 1959. That the purchasers paid the sum of Fourteen Dollars and Fifty-six Cents and Seventy-six Dollars and Eighty-five Cents, respectively toward the purchase of said parcels of real estate including taxes, interest,
