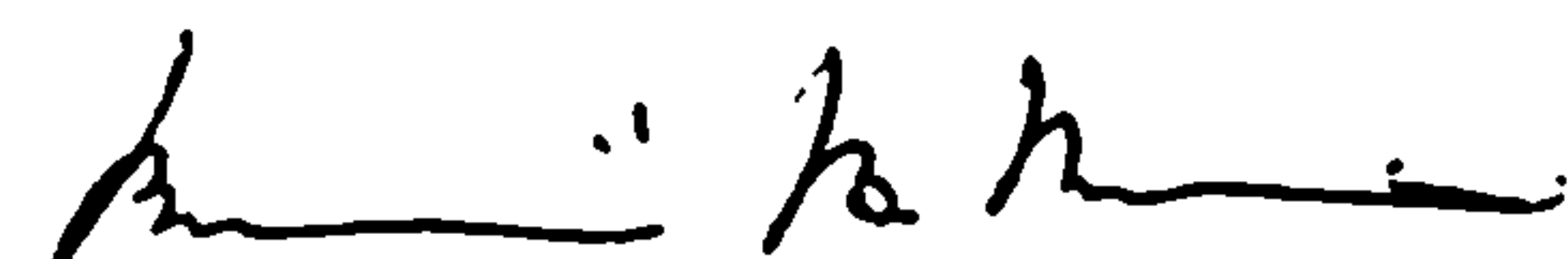
SECOND: That his principal, Robert L. Warfield, is ready, willing and able to carry out the terms of said Agreement which is filed herein as an Exhibit.
