WHEREAS, Benjamin F. Zimmerman of Frederick, Route # 4, County of Frederick in said District, has been duly adjudged a bankrupt, under the Acts of Congress relating to bankruptcy, and appears to have conformed to all the requirements of law in that behalf.

It is, therefore, ordered by the Court that said Benjamin F. Zimmerman be discharged from all debts and claims which are made provable by said Acts against his estate, and which existed on the 18th day of February, A. D. 1933, on which day the petition for adjudication was filed by him; excepting such debts as are by law excepted from the operation of a discharge in bankruptcy.
