4. That the property hereinbefore described has not been redeemed by any party in interest although more than one year and one day from the day of sale, April 10th, 1961, has expired.

5. That there is filed herewith a statement from Charlotte W. Yarroll, County Treasurer of Frederick County, Maryland, showing the amount necessary to redeem said property, which statement is filed herewith as Exhibit No. 2, and prayed to be taken as a part hereof.

TO THE END THEREFORE:

That a final Decree may be passed by your Honorable Court foreclosing all rights of redemption of the Defendants herein, in and to the property hereinbefore set forth, and that the County Treasurer of Frederick County, Maryland, be directed to prepare and execute a deed in fee simple unto Harry K. Green and Ethel V. Green, his wife, the plaintiffs herein, upon payment by them of the purchase price of the property in full, together with all taxes, interest and penalties thereon accruing subsequent to the date of sale.

And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.

May it please your Honors to grant unto the Plaintiffs a ORDER OF PUBLICATION giving notice to Irving Johnson and Loretta Moranz Johnson, his wife, whose last known address is 7008 Vinevale Avenue, Bell, California; Esther Heist and Myrl A. Heist, her husband, whose last known address is Boulder, Colorado; Estella Segal and \_\_\_\_\_, Segal, her husband, whose last known address is 8110 Luella Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, and to all persons known or unknown, and whether residents or non-residents of the State of Maryland, having or claiming to have any interest in property, one (1) acre, more or less, with the improvements thereon, on Weller Road, lying and being in New Market District, No. 9, Frederick County, Maryland, assessed in the name of Rosa Chaney, a.k.a. Rosie Chaney, a.k.a. Rosella Chaney, commanding them and each of them to appear in this Court on or before a certain day to be named therein not less than sixty days from the date of the filing of this Bill of Complaint, and answer said Bill of Complaint or redeem said property, and warning them and each of them upon their failure to do so a final decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the said property; and also that a Writ of Subpoena be issued
