Q You understand that if you are appointed you would have to get Court orders for the sale of the property or for any use of the funds for her and all?

A I didn't know, but if it is--

Q If you were appointed as Committee you would merely be an administrator over the assets of your mother under the jurisdiction of the Court, and in order to sell the property it would require a Court order, and to invade the principal it would require a Court order.

A It isn't something that you can just deal with as an individual, and is that very much involved?

Q Well, Mr. Barrick can explain it to you, what all would be involved. There would have to be a petition filed and I suppose the funds ought to be invested, which would require a Court order. Does your mother understand these things?

A Well, I told her last night we were talking about it. She said about she got the papers out at the Home and some of the girls thought it was nasty of me and all. I explained to her what it was about and I told her what we were doing. I said the reason we were doing it was because at times she didn't actually understand and doesn't recall what she is doing. She will want to do something and then it is a different story, she doesn't want to, and right now she is real congenial about the home up there. Maybe in another week she might not be.

Q Apparently she has at times--

A She has times of depression.
