ORDER OF PUBLICATION

The object of this proceeding is to secure the foreclosure of all rights, of redemption in the following property located at 23 S. The Bill of Complaints states among other things, that the amounts necessary for the redemption of the lot or parcel of land have not been paid, although more than a year and a day from the date of sale has expired.

It is thereupon, this 6th day of November, 1961, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof:

ORDERED, That notice be given by the insertion of a copy of this Order in some newspaper having a general circulation in Frederick County, Maryland, once a week for four successive weeks, warning all persons interested in said property to be and appear in this Court by the 12th day of January, 1962, and redeem the property Part of Lot #8, 23 S. Virginia Avenue, Brunswick, Brunswick District, Frederick County, Maryland, together with the improvements thereon, etc., and answer the bill or thereafter a final decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the property, and vesting in the plaintiff a title, free and clear of all encumbrances.
