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Q To your knowledge, they had no children living at that time?

A No, they only had one daughter and she died at a very early age.

Q (The Court) The last time you saw Sarah was about 30 years ago?

A That's right.

Q At that time was she still married to John and living with John?

A Oh yes, happily living together in Pittsburgh. I went for a visit to see her.

(Mr. Burgee)

Q Do you know the approximate date^{when} your mother and your aunt went to live in the property at Petersville?

A After my grandmother died, she went to take care of my grandmother, you know, when she was ill, and then afterwards she came back to New Haven and worked a while till she got tired. Then she came back to Petersville to live. She went down and spent the rest of her days there. She was up in years.

Q Was your mother living there when she died?

A Oh, no, sir.

Q But your Aunt Cora was? A. Yes.

Q Your Aunt Cora died while living there?

A Yes.

Q Do you know who paid the taxes on this property over here? Who has been paying the taxes on it?

A Since my aunt died and my mother died I have - my sister and I have paid them for years.

Q And so far as you know Cora paid those taxes prior to her death?

A Oh yes, she and my mother paid them then.

Q That would be for the period from your grandmother's death to the period when your aunt died?

A That's right.

MR. BURGEE: That is all the questions I have, Your Honor.

Q (The Court) You are Mrs. Taylor?
