IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN:

I, DAVID M. DEVILBISS, being of sound and disposing mind, do hereby make, publish and declare, as and for my LAST WILL and TESTAMENT, the following:

FIRST: I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid by my Executor, hereinafter named.

SECOND: I hereby give and bequeathe unto my daughter, MARGARET E. DEVILBISS, the sum of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS.

THIRD: I hereby give and devise my home in Johnsville, Maryland, and all that it contains unto my wife, HARRIET V. DEVILBISS, during her widowhood.

FOURTH: Upon the death or remarriage of my said wife, I hereby give and devise said home and all that it contains unto my daughter, Margaret E. Devilbiss, as long as she remains unmarried.

FIFTH: Upon the death or marriage of my said daughter, Margaret E. Devilbiss, said home shall be sold by my Executor, hereinafter named, and the proceeds thereof, including the proceeds of the sale of the contents of said home, shall be divided equally among my children.

SIXTH: All the rest and residue of my estate, of every kind, character and description, and wheresoever situate, shall be held in trust by my son, GEORGE P. DEVILBISS, who shall pay the net income, rents and profits arising therefrom unto my wife, Harriet V. Devilbiss, as long as she remains my widow, with full power to my said Trustee to sell, invest and re-invest said residue, including my farm and any other real estate, except the home, aforesaid, during the widowhood of my said wife, if my said Trustee shall deem said sale for the best interest of my estate.
