TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of The Farmers and Mechanics National Bank of Fred-  
erick, a body corporate, Trustee in the above entitled cause, respect-  
fully represents unto your Honorable court:

FIRST: That the said Charles H. Storr died leaving a last Will and  
Testament dated October 18, 1948, which said Will is recorded in Liber  
H. D. R. No. 1, folio 257, one of the Will Records in the office of the  
Register of Wills for Frederick County, certified copy of which is filed  
herewith marked Exhibit No. 1 to this Petition.

SECOND: That in said Will the testator provided as follows:

"Item 3. I give, devise and bequeath the rest and residue of my  
property and estate, whether consisting of real, personal or  
mixed property, and wheresoever situate, unto The Farmers and  
Mechanics National Bank of Frederick, a body corporate, in trust,  
nevertheless, to invest and re-invest the same and pay the net  
income and principal as follows:

a. I direct my Trustee to divide my estate into three  
equal parts, and from one-third part, I direct my Trustee  
to pay to Kathryn A. Snook the sum of \$1000.00 and my  
automobile for her kindness to me. The remainder of said  
one-third I direct my Trustee to invest and re-invest the  
same and pay the net income therefrom to my niece, Kathryn  
A. Snook, for and during the term of her natural life, and  
upon the death of the said Kathryn A. Snook, I direct that  
said Trust cease, and I give, devise and bequeath said one-  
third of said corpus, together with any accumulative income,  
to her descendants. But if the said Kathryn A. Snook should  
die without leaving any descendants, then I direct that said  
trust cease as to the balance of said one-third, and I give,  
devise and bequeath the same to the Hoffman Reformed Orphan-  
age, Littlestown, Pennsylvania.

b. As to the second one-third of said corpus, I direct my  
said Trustee to pay to Irene P. Zimmerman the net income  
from said one-third until her son, Charles R. Zimmerman,  
reaches the age of twenty-one years, and upon his reaching  
said age, then I direct that said trust cease as to said  
one-third of the residue of my estate, and I direct that  
my Trustee pay, and I so give, devise and bequeath said one-  
third of the corpus, together with any accumulative income,  
unto William Etchison Zimmerman, Charles R. Zimmerman and  
Johanna Irene Zimmerman, equally, share and share alike. If  
any one or two of the above mentioned children of Irene P.  
Zimmerman should die before receiving their legacy, then  
I give, devise and bequeath the share of the child or children  
so dying to the survivors or survivor.
