TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Farmers and Mechanics National Bank, formerly Farmers and Mechanics - Citizens National Bank of Frederick, formerly The Farmers and Mechanics National Bank of Frederick, a body corporate, Trustee under the Will of Charles H. Storr, late of Frederick County, deceased, by Benjamin B. Rosenstock, its Solicitor, respectfully shows unto Your Honors:

FIRST: That your Petitioner was nominated and appointed Trustee under the Will of Charles H. Storr dated October 18, 1948, and recorded in Will Record Liber H. D. R. # 1, folio 257, one of the Will Records in the Office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County filed in these proceedings as Exhibit No. 1, and your Honorable Court assumed jurisdiction thereof on the 1st day of May, ¹⁹⁵⁰~~1951~~.

SECOND: That by said Last Will and Testament, the residue of the estate was divided into three parts designated as Item 3 (a), (b) and (c), each of which trusts have a one-third undivided interest in all the corpus.

THIRD: That among the assets in the above entitled trusts is a dwelling house located at No. 305 West Fifth Street, Frederick, Maryland, that has been carried in these trusts at a fair market value of Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$9,500.00). This dwelling has been rented for a number of years, but has been recently vacated by the tenant and as your Petitioner's accounts have revealed has produced very little revenue; that your
