And lastly I hereby constitute and appoint my sons John W. Bussard Peter E. Bussard, Joseph H. Bussard, Daniel L. Bussard, Samuel D. Bussard and Charles L. Bussard to be the Executors of this my last Will and testament hereby ~~revoking~~ limiting their joint compensation as such Executors to the sum of Six Hundred Dollars in lieu of all commissions allowed by law hereby revoking all former wills by me heretofore made and ratifying and confirming this and none other as and for my last Will and testament. This is the first codicil to the last Will and Testament of me Peter H. Bussard, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland which is dated August 1st. in the year 1903 w

Whereas in my said Will I direct my executors to sell all my personal property not in said will specifically bequeathed either at public or private sale at their discretion, now it is my will that all posts and rails and fencing material which may be on my farm where I Now reside at the time of my death, and which were placed there for the purpose of repairing fences or building new fences on said farm shall not be appraised or sold by my said Executors, but that the same shall be considered for the purposes of this will as a part of my said home farm and shall pass with said farm under the provision of my said will.

It is my further Will that the Orphans Court for Frederick County shall not require any Bond from my Executors named in my said Will but that they shall act without Bond, I having full confidence that they will faithfully execute the provisions of my said Will without this measure of protection, in all other respects I ratify and confirm my aforesaid will.
