I am in receipt of your request of
December 8 for information concerning our
School of Law.

Under the general laws of this State
the University maintains the Princess Anne Academy
as a separate institution of higher learning for
the education of Negroes. In order to insure equality
of opportunity for all citizens of this State, the 1933
Legislature passed Chapter 234, creating partial scholar-
ships at Morgan College or institutions outside of the
State for Negro students who may desire to take profes-
sional courses or other work not given at the Princess
Anne Academy.

Should you desire to make application for such
scholarship notify me, and I will see that such appli-
cation is duly filed.
