frequently numbered 60, or more. During the earlier years rather more persons came from Maryland, than from West Virginia, but later, the attendance from Bayard was larger. By agreement with the Diocesan Authority, the Chapel always remained private property.

Through changed economic conditions which caused the removal from the neighborhood of those for whom, chiefly, Corunna

Chapel was erected, its usefulness at that point had passed away. In June, 1913, Mr. W. McCulloh Brown, who desired the Chapel to be of service, offered it to the Bishop of the Diocese, and he to the Nativity Congregation at Cedarcroft. In September, 1913, it was dismantled, and shipped to Baltimore, some 240 miles by rail, and was re-erected on the Chapel lot at Cedarcroft.

The two exterior views here presented, were taken before Emmanuel Chapel was finished, and therefore do not give the best impression of the original building, but they are shown in connection with two later views of the Chapel of the Nativity, taken from similar points, as suggestive of the changes which have been made.

THE CHAPEL OF THE NATIVITY.

HISTORY.

On Sunday, February 20th, 1910, at 8 P. M., in a residence on Evesham Avenue, Govans, and again on Sunday, March 20th, 1910, at 8 P. M., in a residence on the York Road, Govans, Evening Prayer was said, and offerings taken and reserved for the Building Fund for a new Church in that neighborhood.

At the meeting of the Archdeaconry of Towson, held at the Church of the Redeemer, June 1st, 1910, the minutes of the Secretary record the report of the above mentioned services, the location and cost of a desirable lot at Cedarcroft, and of a request made previously to the Bishop to reserve the name of the "Church of the Nativity" for the Church in contemplation.

February 9th, 1911—Purchase by the Church Extension Society of the Diocese of Maryland, at a cost of \$5,000.00, in a new and growing section of Govans, known as Cedarcroft, of a beautiful and commanding site, averaging 150 feet on the York Road, and 250 feet on Cedarcroft Road.

Upon the Feast of the Nativity, Monday, December 25th, 1911, at 8 A. M., in the rooms of the Neighborhood Improvement Club, York Road, Govans, the first of the regular services was held, that of the Holy Communion, 12 persons being present.

On the following Sunday, December 31st, 1911, the first session of the Sunday School was held at 3 o'clock, and the first regular service of Evening Prayer at 4 o'clock.

Sunday, June 2nd, 1912—The "Nativity" removed from the Club Rooms to the Office Building of the Cedarcroft Land Company, on Cedarcroft Road, opposite the Chapel lot.

Thursday, August 28th, 1913—Ground broken for the Chapel of the Nativity.

Upon the Feast of the Nativity, Thursday, December 25th, 1913, the Congregation removed from the Office Building to the Parish Room of the Chapel of the Nativity, where the first service was held at 8 A. M., 60 persons being present.

Sunday, February 1st, 1914—The first service was held in the Chapel.

On Easter Sunday, April 12th, 1914, at 4 P. M., the Choir of 12 women and 6 men, was vested for the first time.

April 28th, 1915—The Parish Hall in Basement, 65 feet by 25 feet, 8 feet deep, with rooms under Parish and Choir Rooms, and with cement floor throughout, was partially completed and was used for the first time.

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Ground was broken Thursday morning at Cedarcroft avenue and York road, Govans, for a chapel building for the congregation of the Protestant Episcopal Chapel of the Nativity.

The entire building will be 64 feet long by 25 feet wide, with vestry and Sunday-school rooms on either side 20 by 13 feet. The height of the main structure will be 24 feet from the floor to the centre of the peak roof. A tower, which will form the main entrance, will be eight feet square. The nave will be 40 feet long by 25 feet wide, and the chancel and sanctuary are to extend 24 feet in depth. The frame of hemlock is most substantial. The interior, finished throughout in oak and ash, will be in natural color. The floors are to be of oak. The exterior will be stucco, with dark green trimmings and slate roof.

The chapel building, for which foundations are now being prepared, was secured in Garrett county, Md., a short distance from the town of Bayard, W. Va. It was known as Corona Chapel, and was erected there some years ago on a commanding site overlooking the Alleghenies, where it rendered valuable service to a large number of people. Through changed conditions its usefulness at that point has passed away and it is the wish of the donor, W. McCulloh Brown, of Bayard, to have it placed where it may be of service.

When completed the nave and tower, with the exception of the stucco exterior and slate roof, will be practically as they were when first erected. The chancel and the adjoining rooms, however, will have been considerably enlarged. Some stately oaks now standing beside Corona Chapel will be felled to provide timbers for the enlargement. The building is now being taken down in preparation for its removal to Baltimore.

The chapel will occupy the western half of the central lot of the Nativity holding, the remainder of the land between it and the York road being reserved for the future church and the land on the other side for the rectory. It is planned to erect in the future a parish building adjoining the chapel in the rear.

The congregation of the Chapel of the Nativity was organized on Christmas Day 1911 in the rooms of the Woman's Improvement Club at Govans by Rev. Charles A. Hensel, rector of the Church of the Redeemer, Charles Street avenue, who has served the congregation from the beginning. The congregation and Sunday-school continued to worship there until June, 1912 when they moved to the office building of the Cedarcroft Land Company.

The chapel will probably be ready for worship in November.
