[Both of these historical accounts of the original churches in the Parish appear to be inaccurate when compared with the earliest parish records, though these latter are confusing.]

Rectors of St. Martin's Church from 1756 to 1800.

The first church in Worcester parish was a small framed house near St. Martin's River. It is uncertain what year it was built, but in 1750 it was sold to James Mumford, & a brick church was built on the same lot, one hundred yards west of the old one. It was finished before '55, & in '56 the Rev. Edward Dingley was rector. He remained rector until his death, & was buried in the church in front of the pulpit when it was on the north side of the church. Mr. Mumford moved the old church off the lot & used it for a barn. In October 1765 Rev. William Macclenachan became rector of the parish & died August 1st 1766, & was buried in the north side of the chancel. The Rev. Samuel Sloan was in the parish one or two years, but it is uncertain when he left. The Rev. John Montgomery became rector about '69 & remained a year or two. Rev. Mr. Patterson was in the parish a few months in 1772 Rev. John Bowie became rector the same year & remained until the fall of 1776 when he was sent to Annapolis & imprisoned by the whigs for being a royalist. There was no minister settled after Mr. Bowie left, until after the peace of 1783. The Rev. William Skelly officiated about one year in '90 & '91. The Rev. John White was rector in '92 & '93, & died in winter or first part of Spring of '93. The Rev. Samuel Tingley became rector in '98 or '99 & died Dec. 99, or Jan 1800, & was buried in front of the chancel in St. Martin's Church.

The above is a copy of a statement written by Miss Aralanta L. W. Robins. She had the account from her father, Mr. Edward Robins.

Worcester Parish is one of the oldest on the Eastern peninsula of Maryland. It extends from the line of Delaware southwardly to the Parish of All Hallows; and from the Potomac River, its western boundary to Sini-puxent Bay, comprehending all the territory lying within the bounds thus described. There being no independent congregations in the Parish.

Formerly Worcester Parish included the Eld at Dagsborough in what is now Sussex Co. Delaware; which for many years was supposed to belong to the state of Maryland; but a survey of the territory with reference to state lines gave Sussex to Delaware; and consequently separated the Church men of Dagsborough and the vicinity from the Diocese of Md & hence from Worcester Parish.

Before this geographical division the parish was both larger, and far more populous than it is at present, though from all ^{gatherings} there do not appear to have been more than two churches in it: ^{the parish church at Dagsborough and the chapel of ^{St. Peter's} ^{near the present site of the} ^{church at Dagsborough} ^{where this chapel was built is not known by the oldest inhabitant but in 1753 it was found necessary to replace by a more substantial and commodious edifice; and measures were begun that resulted in the erection of the present venerable Church of St. Martin, which was completed and used for divine worship in 1756-57. without consecration.}}

The Rev Wm Macclenachan was Rector of the parish at this date and continued in charge down to the 3rd day of Aug. Annd 1766. the date of his decease.

of the death of this gentleman but there were two
or three ministers officiating occasionally, or stated
ly, in the parish between the years 1750 & 60 besides
the Rev W McC. In Jan 1753 the Rev Matthias Harris
was engaged to officiate on the fourth Sunday of every
Month. Rev Mrs Thornton appears to have been connected
with the parish in 1758 in conjunction & in oppose with
Rev Ed Dingle; but whether as a assistant Rector or other
wise does not appear. In the same year, Decemb 1758 Rev
Edward Dingle is said in the Old Register p 99. to
have been, "inducted in Worcester Parish" it is presumed
as a assistant or associate Rector with the Rev W McC.

Mr Dingle died July 1st 1763. leaving the senior
Rector still in charge, after whose death in 1766 there
is a hiatus in the Records extending to the 29th of
March 1806 when Rev David Ball stood upon the
duties of the Rectorship of this parish in connexion with
All Hallows. * How long this connexion continued under
Mr Ball does not appear from the Register, but there
follows the notice of Mr Ball's subscription list, a simi-
lar one for the Rev Hamilton Bell in A.D 1810. more
of whom the register saith not. ~~Another list occurs~~
~~in the same work in 1812. at which time~~
~~Rev Suddah had charge of Worcester in connexion~~
~~with All Hallows.~~

To Mr Ball p Ball succeeded Rev Pomeroy
Smith ^{in 1811} who was elected Rector of Worcester and All Hallows
parishes for one year and as long as the two parishes may jointly
agree to continue said Rector; and said Rector's time shall be
equally divided between said parishes. In 1811. he was en-
gaged only for half the year; with a conditional promise
of being retained for the next six months provided the
vestry were able to make up the sum required for his
support i.e \$400 - The old globe was sold Aug 31st 1811 ~~to~~ by

the vestry, at public sale, to Bibritha Grey, at six dollars per acre
the whole, for which he gave his note, payable to the vestry
at the end of three years, being \$321.00. ~~and~~ ^{and} 150.00

Mr P. Smith continued in charge of the parishes down
to the close of the summer of 1819. when he resigned. The vestry of All
Hallows were desirous of securing the services of Rev S. C. Stratton
for the vacant parishes; but the Rev Henry Suddah was chosen
as Rector; as it appears from the Records of a meeting of the
vestry of Worcester parish held March 18th 1820. and continued in
charge down to the close of 1822. when he resigned the parish; and
was succeeded by Rev S. C. Stratton; who accepted the invitation
given him by the vestry of Worcester parish on the 15th Jan 1824.

About this time the effect of irregular ^{how many years past} services on
the part of the Rectors, at St Martin's Chh, ~~and~~ ^{and} the active
encroachments of the Sects upon the parish, began to be
seen and felt by all the members of the Chh. The con-
gregations were growing thin. There was but one mem-
ber of the communion living between St Martin's and
the present line of Delaware; and the major part lived
from six to twelve miles south and east of the Chh and
found it very inconvenient to ride so far, sometimes
to service, sometimes to a disappointment; through the
failure of the Rector; who usually resided at, or near Snow
Hill, twenty two miles distant; and decline in the con-
gregation both as to number and interest became
painfully visible. The Methodists were known in the full
vigour of Neophytic zeal in this part of the peninsula
and here as elsewhere, the Chh from whose communion
they had originally withdrawn, into schism, was the chief
object of attack: they seized the advantage presented by the
embarrassments under which the parishes of Worcester Co.
laboured; invaded her borders and spirited away a large
number of her people: and it was feared by those who stood
firmest, that the parish of Worcester, especially, would be broken
in up. But those who loved the gates of Zion set out
to avert this catastrophe by choosing a more central spot
as to the congregation, on which to build a new Church, that

would be more accessible by the people living in Beauparc
and Buckingham hundred; all of whom concurred
in the project; and subscribed liberally towards the sum
required, in addition to the price of the old glebe, which
had been sold as before stated, for the erection of the con-
templated Church edifice; which it was decided to
build in the village of Berlin as the most central spot,
as to the people who desired to attend the services of
the Chh in this neighbourhood.

The whole amt needed was thus raised in
the parish and in eighteen hundred and twenty
five St Pauls Church Worcester Parish was built
under the direction of Rev S. C. Stratton, Ed. Robinson
Dr. P. P. and Mrs N. Williams Esq.

The house has no pretension to architectural
taste; it belongs to no particular order: but it
served the purpose in view. It was a rallying
point for the remaining members and friends
of the Church; who settled around it in consider-
able number and built up a village of some
five or six hundred inhabitants in the course
of ten or fifteen years. The new Church was consecrated
by Rev Kemp. Mr Stratton continued in charge of the
united parishes down to July 1st 1831. succeeded by
Rev Geo Wiley Decem-15th 1832 resigned March 1834. In
Oct of the same year Mr Stratton was again invited to the charge
of the parish; but an arrangement to that effect could not be
accomplished and after some further delay, the Rev. Hoop was
elected Rector of both parishes which continued in union
to their mutual detriment under the successive Rector-
ship of Rev Lab Noble Rev Wm. Clark & Rev W. A. Reeds
down to 1844 when the parishes were separated. Mr Reeds
continuing in charge of All Hallows. Worcester parish
having called the present Rector began again to exist
independently; and though full as compared with
itself in the time of old, is yet not without hope of

regaining much of the ground lost during the past thirty years.

The Church of St Martin which had been neglected from
the time St Pauls was built in Berlin, and had of consequence
suffered abuse, the people of the neighbourhood acting as
if it was a barn; the windows broken the plastering torn
in places from the walls and ceiling; the endowments, even those
about the graves in the yard, carried off or partially repaired
in 1842 by the people of the parish; and put in condition for
use at least in the summer season; and solemnly set apart
to the worship of Almighty God by the Rt Rev Bishop of the Diocese
W. Rollinson Whittingham D.D. in the fall of 1845. Mr Reeds
had Divine service there every other Sunday afternoon; and
as the prospect was encouraging, the services have been kept
up by the present Rector, who living nearer to the Church than
his predecessor, officiates there every Sunday afternoon, encour-
aged by the hope of repairing the evils of an unbridled enthusi-
asm and doing substantial good if it be but small in and
to the minds and souls of the people of the vicinity, by the blessed
gospel of the Grace of God in his body the Church.

Of the vicinity of St Martin as affected by Metho-
dism I hope may be excused for saying a few words not in the
spirit of censure or uncharitableness; but of calm, sober judg-
ment upon palpable results. Methodism has enjoyed an
uninterrupted popularity of that vicinity, extending to the line
of Delaware, and embracing a very considerable population
once known as the most respectable in Worcester County for the
space of twenty five years. Their Meeting houses
sprung up every where; the schism grew wonderfully
as before stated many members of the Church were led
away, under the false notion that she had no religion
in her, and, "these were the men." They worked their
will without interruption; and in circumstances
eminently calculated to test Wesley's system fairly
and fully; and with what result? What has it done
for St Martin? If the great, the wonderful igno-
rance, and depravity for which the neighbourhood

is now alas notorious, be not chargeable directly upon
Methodism, and I do not affirm that it is, yet this
conclusion is unavoidable, Methodism has done
nothing to avert the downward tendencies of hu-
man nature among these people - it possesses no-
thing calculated for this end; and indirectly does
demoralise the Mass, by lowering the standard of
morality and religion, and conduces to ignorance
by the practical substitution of bodily exercises
which profit nothing says St Paul, for instruction
in the doctrines and precepts of Revelation.

In conclusion the Church owes a vast debt to
this poor vicinity, accruing from many years of
partial and of total neglect of her high and re-
sponsible duties, when she had entire possession
of the ground; she owes it to herself, to her Divine
Master to repair, if God will it, these waste places
to give the people thereof light for darkness and
bring them from the power of Satan unto God.

And to my Successor, I leave at once the continuation
of this Manger Watch; and the fostering of poor old
St. Martin's. God so bless and prosper you that you
may add immeasurably to the little good accom-
plished by my worthy predecessor and myself, both
instruments in the hand of our Divine Master.

In Nov. 1850 Rev. Samuel W. Stewart, then in Deacon's
order, was called to the ^{charge} Rectory of this parish.
He accepted the call, & entered upon his duties as
Minister in charge of the parish Dec. 21st of that year.

In May 1851 he was ordained Priest in St. Paul's
Church, Berlin. He remained & continued to dis-
charge the duties of Rector until Nov. 23rd 1868.
Except during 1867 when unable to discharge the
duties, he conducted services regularly in St.
Martin's Church every alternate Sunday, P. M. during

The Summer & Autumn, it being impractica-
ble to get congregations there at other seasons.
For several seasons, Sunday School was held there
on each Sunday, on which there was service, but
finding it impossible to get the children of that neigh-
borhood together for such purpose it was discontinued.

During the seasons in which services were held in
St. Martin's, on the alternate Sundays, services were held
first at the residence of Mr. James Waters in Simpson's
Court, & afterwards in the different School houses in that
neck, until the last year he was in the parish
when he deemed it inexpedient to omit the service
in Berlin for the very small number that attended
in those places.

He refers to the Parish Register & the condition of
the parish for the measure of success attending
his labors. May there be good seed sown which
will yet bud, spring forth & bear much fruit. &
may his Successor find much more to encour-
age him, & his labors be attended with more
abundant fruit.

He took charge of the Parish on the 7th of Nov.
1869 and remained Rector a year and ten
months. I trust that my brief Ministry has
not been without result, and pray that God's
blessing may abundantly rest on the labors of
my Successor.
