History.

The present parish of St Lukes, Queen Annes & Talbot Comities was formerly a part of St. Pauls Parish Queen Annes & Talbot. In the year 1859 by consent of the Vestry & Rector of St Pauls; and also by consent of the Convention of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Maryland, it was erected into a separate Parish. The territory included within the new Parish called "Mye Parish" (the Churches within said Parish being named St Lukes Church Mye & St Lukes Chapel Queen Annes) is as follows according to their boundaries viz. "Beginning at a point, where Reed's Creek empties into the Chester River, and running up said creek to its head; thence in a direct line across to a point, where a stream of water, commonly called "Madame Elsie's branch" crosses the main road, from Crutwille to Easton; thence in a direct line to a bridge, on the main road from "Mye Mills", to Hillsborough, situated on a farm, known as the Nicholson farm, or to whatever point, the said direct line shall strike the boundary line between Queen Annes & Talbot Comities, and St Johns Parish, Caroline County; thence with the line of that part of St Pauls Parish, lying below the line of division these streams, until they come to the point, started from, where Reed's Creek empties into the Chester river"

The Parish was organized by the election on _____ day of _____ 1860 of the following gentlemen as Vestrymen & Wardens.

The Act of the Convention establishing the Parish of Mye was passed May 30th 1860.

History.

The Rev. Albert Ware accepted a call to this Parish in July 1880. He resigned charge of his parishes in Virginia & entered on his duties here on the 19th day of August 1880.

He continued in charge of Wye Parish until 10th day July ¹⁸⁸⁸ when he resigned & entered on his duties as Rector of North Kent Parish.
