first day Bee it enacted by the L<sup>d</sup> Prop<sup>r</sup> of & w<sup>th</sup> the advise & assent of the ffreemen of the province th<sup>t</sup> his L<sup>ps</sup>. Councill pñt in the pro: & these sixteene persons Cap<sup>t</sup> Jn<sup>o</sup> Price, Rob<sup>t</sup> Vaughan, m<sup>r</sup> ffenwick, M<sup>r</sup> Bradnox, m<sup>r</sup> Conner m<sup>r</sup> Thorneborough, m<sup>r</sup> Brookes, Tho. Allen, Rich: Banks, Barnaby Jackson, George Saphyer, George Akerick Jn<sup>o</sup> Medley, Water Waterlin, Walter Pakes, Edward Packer, or any Ten of them, assembled w<sup>th</sup> the Gou<sup>r</sup> & the Clerk of the Assembly att the time & place prefixed by the Gou<sup>r</sup> shall be a Howse of Assembly to all intents & purposes. And all Bills passed by the s<sup>d</sup> ffreemen or the maior part of them, & enacted by the Gou<sup>r</sup> shall be Lawes of the Pro: after publicaõn thereof, under the hand of the Gou<sup>r</sup> and the pñt scale of the pro: as fully to all effects in Law as if they were aduised & assented unto by all the ffreemen of the pro: in person.

The ffreemen bownd to attend the Assembly appeared except m<sup>r</sup> ffenwick, m<sup>r</sup> Thorneborough, M<sup>r</sup> Brookes & George Saphyer

Summons to George Saphyer to be att the Assembly forthw<sup>th</sup>  
vpon sight &c

was read certaine orders to be obserued in the howse during  
the Assembly

Came M<sup>rs</sup> Margarett Brent and requested to have vote in the  
howse for her selfe and voyce allso for that att the last Court  
3<sup>d</sup> Jan: it was ordered that the said M<sup>rs</sup> Brent was to be lookd  
vpon and received as his L<sup>ps</sup> Attorney. The Gou<sup>r</sup> denyed  
that the s<sup>d</sup> M<sup>rs</sup> Brent should have any uote in the howse. And  
the s<sup>d</sup> M<sup>rs</sup> Brent protested agst all proceedings in this pñt  
Assembly, unlesse shee may be pñt. and have vote as afores<sup>d</sup>
