 p. 19 not thereupon issued We Therefore Comānd you th^t by good & Lawfull men of yo^r Bayliwick you m[ake known] to the s^d Jo. Balley th^t he be before o^r Justices of [our next] Pro^{all} Cr^t to be held at the City of S^t Maries the [14th day] of Aprill next to Shew Cause if anie he have [why] Execucon should not Issue forth ag^t him upon the s[ame Judgm^t] & how you shall execute this Writ you make knowne to [] Justices & have you there this writ Witnes o^r Deare so[nne] Charles Calvert o^r Captaine Gen^{ll} & Cheife Justice [of our] s^d Province the 13th day of ffebruary in the 42th yeare &c Annoq dni 1673.
