 Edmundson and Mary Tilhman Execut^r of Richard Tilghman
 decd pl^{ts} in the Writt of Error here depending ag^t Jn^o Quigly
 Def^t and The Def^{ts} Demurrer to the errors assigned being
 fully argued on both Sides it was found that there was a mis-
 prision of the Clerke in entering of the Speciall Bayle given by
 Blackhall in the Prov^{all} Court and this house being of opinion
 th^t the Said misprision might have been amended in the Pro-
 v^{all} Court it Self by the Judges there within a certaine time, It
 was ordered here th^t the Record be brought into this house to
 be amended in point of speciall Bayle aforesaid which was
 done accordingly and therefore it is Considered here th^t the
 bayle be discharged, the parties Dismissed each paying their
 owne Costs and th^t nothing of this Proceedings be intended to
 destroy the Judgem^t in the Prov^{all} Court ag^t The Principall
 Blackhall
