

Liber F. and Command that the housekeepers of the other part of S<sup>t</sup> Michael's hundred from Trinity Creek Southward doe carry their women and Children unto the house of Thomas Steerman, and that Lieutenant Thomas Baldrige take charge of the S<sup>d</sup> Southern part and keep Guard in like manner as is afore appointed for S<sup>t</sup> Inego's, and further that the housekeepers of S<sup>t</sup> George's hundred, doe carry their women and Children to the house of M<sup>r</sup> Weston, Such house as Shall be thought most defensible by George Pye late Burgess of that hundred and that Said George Pye take charge and Command of the Said hundred of all the men able to bear arms within the Said hundred and appoint and keep Guard in like manner as is afore appointed for S<sup>t</sup> Michael's hundred and that all Several persons of the S<sup>d</sup> Several hundreds able to bear arms be obedient and assistant unto the Said Several persons respectively appointed to take Charge and Command thereof as aforesaid as they will Answ<sup>r</sup> the Contrary at their perill and of all the Several Commands a<sup>d</sup> I doe hereby require every one to take

To all and singular persons to whom these p<sup>nts</sup> shall come, Greeting. Know ye that we for divers speciall considerations vs therevnto moving, have revoked and determined, and by these p<sup>nts</sup> doe declare that we doe hereby revoke and absolutely determine all former Commissions heretofore granted vnto our deare brother Leonard Calvert Esq or to any other person whatsoever, for or concerning the govern<sup>t</sup> of o<sup>r</sup> said Province of Maryland, and all power & authority by vs thereby granted vnto him or to any other of o<sup>r</sup> Councill or to any other person or persons whatsoever in & by the said Commissions or any of them. And we doe hereby likewise discharge all & every pson & psons whatsoever from our Councill, and to be of o<sup>r</sup> Councill within the said Province of Maryland, w<sup>ch</sup> heretofore have beene of o<sup>r</sup> Councill there.
