

Liber H. H. Edward Eltonhead, then his L<sup>o</sup> Authorizes & requires his s<sup>d</sup> Lieu<sup>t</sup> & Keeper of his Greate Seale to cause an Exemplification to be forthwith made & passed vnder his said Lordships Newe Greate Seale of the said Grant or Pattent vpon Record there & to send the said Exemplification by the first opportunity to his L<sup>o</sup> for the said Edward Eltonhead.

4. That his Lordship doth heereby Authorize his said Lieu<sup>t</sup> of the said Province with the advice & approbacōn of his Lo<sup>s</sup> said Brother to readmitt if he thinke fitt M<sup>r</sup> Robert Clarke to be One of his L<sup>o</sup>s Councell of the said Province to all intents & purposes whatsoever in as full & ample manner as formerly he was by his L<sup>o</sup>s Comission for that purpose to him and also to add any other Person or persons inhabiteing the said Province not exceeding the number of six to be of his L<sup>o</sup>s Councell there to all intents & Purposes ouer & aboue such as are allready or that shall heereafter be nominated & appointed by his L<sup>o</sup> to be of his Lo<sup>s</sup> Councell there Provided that such person or persons so to be added to his L<sup>o</sup>s Councell there as aforesaid do take the Oath of a Councellor there to his L<sup>o</sup> before he or they do Act as one of his Lordships Councell there respectively.

5. That his Lordship doth heereby Authorize his Lieu<sup>t</sup> of the said Province for the time beeing with the Approbacōn of any three of his of his Lordships Councell there whereof his L<sup>o</sup>s Principall Secretary for the time beeing to be allways one to make any Forreigner as he shall thinke fitt capeable of his L<sup>o</sup>s Condicons of Plantacon there & to cause Grants or Pattents of land there to be passed vnto any such person or Persons accordingly as if he she or they were of Brittish or Irish descent any former Commission Warrant or direction from his L<sup>o</sup> to the Contrary in any wise Notwithstanding.

6. Whereas his L<sup>o</sup> hath in these Instructions & otherwise Authorized & appointed his Lieu<sup>t</sup> of the said Province for the time beeing & in particular the aforesaid Captaine Iosias Fendall his Lordships present Lieu<sup>t</sup> there to Act & do seuerall things with the advice & approbacōn of his L<sup>o</sup>s Brother Philip Calvert Esq<sup>r</sup> Nowe In case the said Philip Calvert should dye or by absence out of the said Province or otherwise should be disapointed of Acting there accordingly His Lo<sup>s</sup> doth heereby Authorize & appoint in euery such case the said Captaine Josias Fendall & euery other his L<sup>o</sup>s Lieu<sup>t</sup> of the of the said Province for the time beeing to Act & Doe the same things
