These are in the name of the Lord Proprietary to will and require yow forthwith to make your repaire to the howse where the Court hath vsually bene kept in Charles County, and there to reade, or cause to be read openly the said letter from his Ma^{ty} Together with the Proclamation of his Ma^{ty} and afterwards those other two for comand-ing Obedience to his lo^{ps} Gouvernment vnder me his Lieutenant here, and of Pardon to the Jnhabitants of Charles County And for soe doing this shalbe your Warrant Giuen vnder my hand and Seale this 27th day of Nouember 1660 Yow are to make retourne of this Warrant within fflower and twenty howers after yow haue executed it

Proclamation
By the Gouvernor & Councill of Maryland

P. 79

Whereas Josias Fendall late Gouvernor of this Province of Maryland hath contrary to his Oath and Trust raised Sedition against the Gouvernment of the Right honno^{ble} the Lord Proprietary, And whereas the King's Most Excellent Ma^{ty} in protection of his Lo^{ps} iust Right hath bene Graciously pleased by his Letters directed to the Gouvernor and Councill of Virginea and to all Captaines and Masters of Ships tradeing to Maryland And to all Magistrats and Officers, and other his Ma^{ties} loyall Subiects in these parts to require them to be ayding and assisting to his Lo^{ps} Officers in the settlment of his Lo^{ps} Jurisdiction here, ffor avoiding of Bloudshed, And least apprehension of Guilt and punishment should engage persons otherwise Capable of his Lo^{ps} mercy in Second and vnardonable Crymes, J Doe hereby in his lordships name Proclaime a ffree and Gennerall Pardon to all persons now inhabiting and residing within Charles County who were engaged in the late Mutiny and Sedition for any Cryme by them Committed in the said Mutiny (Except Josias fendall and John Hatch, Provided they Doe imediatly Submitt to his lordships Gouvernment now established vnder me his lordships Lieutenant and other his Officers here Giuen at Saint Maryes vnder my hand this 27th day of Nouember 1660
