That Whereas at a Provinciall Co^rt held at S^t Marys the 28th of February 1660 there then passed an order that yo^r pet^r should haue a yeares tyme allowed him for the disposall of his Estate and then to departe this Province, Since which tyme yo^r pet^r hath had noe oppertunity to dispose of his said Estate Wherefore it is the humble desire of yo^r pet^r that yo^r Honors will be pleased to take it into yo^r Consideracōns and order that the former order of the 28th of February 1660 be made voyd and yo^r pet^r thereby made capable of Continuing in this Province and ordering his small Estate to his best advantage as the rest of his Lo^{ps} Tenants in this his Lō^{ps} Province may doe
