conveyance then formerly. The County desires earnestly to have the Acts sent vpp that p. 153 they may bee published and knowen. Sr J suppose it will bee very necessary to inquire and indeauor to procure as much Amunition as can bee gott least wee bee destitute in tyme of neede, for J doubt there is greate want of it. J heard nothinge of your Sloope though J inquired of one that had been at my Plantation on Freyday last. Wth my seruice presented to my Lord and Mr Sewall, and not forgettinge my due respects to

mr Caluert I take leaue and Rest.
