p. 165 ffebruary Cæcilius Absolute Lord & Proprietary of the Prouinces of Maryland & Aualon, Lord Baron of Baltemore &c: To all Persons to whom these pints shall Come Greeting in Our Lord God Euerlasting. Whereas Emperour Smith Subject to the States of Holland, having transported himselfe into this Prouince here to inhabite, & as a ffree Dennizen ffreedome Land to him & his heyres to purchase. Know yee th^t Wee willing to give due encowragem^t to the subjects of that Nation. Doe hereby declare him the s^d Emperour Smith to bee a ffree Dennizen of this Our Prouince of Maryland. And doe further for Vs our heyres & Successors streightly enjoyne Constitute, ordaine & command That hee the sd Emperour Smith bee in all things held, treated reputed & esteemed as one of the ffaythfull Poeple of Vs our heyres & Successors borne wthin this our Prouince of Maryland. And likewise any Lands, tenemts, Reuenues Seruices & other hereditamts whatsoeur wthin our sd Prouince of Maryland may inherite, or otherwise purchase, receiue take haue hold buy & possesse, & them may Occupy & enioy giue, sell alien & bequeath, as likewise all Liberties & ffranchises of this Our Prouince of Maryland freely quiettly & peaceably haue & possesse, Occupy & enioy as any of Our ffaythfull Poeple borne or to bee borne wthin Our sd Prouince of Maryland, wthout the lett, molestaon uexaon trouble or greiuance of Vs our heyres & Successors Any Custome to the Contrary hereof in any wise notwthstanding. Gyuen att St Maries under the Greate Seale of Our sd Prouince of Maryland this seauenteenth day of ffebruary in the 21th yeare of Our Dominion ouer the sd Prouince Anog Dni 1662.
