March 25. Commisⁿ to Cap^t Will^m Boareman, for trading wth
the Indians. Jdem mutatis mutandis vt est fol^o 161^o
to John Nuttall.

The Bond for those to giue who haue Comisⁿ
to trade wth the Indians.

This day came Cap^t Will^m Boareman Gentⁿ & acknowledged
himsel^f endebted unto the R^t hon^{ble} the L^d Prop^r of this
Prouince in the iust & full sume of fwe hund^d pownds sterl. of
lawfull money of England to bee payd att or afore the day
of next ensuing the date hereof in Case hee the s^d William
Boareman shall not come & yeild up a p^rfect & true accompt
of the Tenth part in weight or ualue of all Comōdities what-
soeu^r traded for with any Indian or Indians whatsoeu^r eyther
by himsel^f or any other p^rson intrusted by him unto the L^d
Prop^r of this Prouince or his heyres, or his or their Leiut^t or
Cheife Gou^r for the time being. Or any other Officers or
Officers by him or them impowred therein, when hee thereunto
shall bee lawfully called. And in Case hee doth trade for any
Corne hee doe not export the same out of this Prouince wthout
Lycence first had & obtayned from the Leiut^t or cheife Gou^r for
the time being. And doe not fullfill all such Condicōns as are
expressed in the last Act Concerning Trade wth the Indians.
ffor the w^{ch} paym^t well & trully to bee made and done hee the
s^d Will^m Boareman doth bind himsel^f his heyres Exec^{rs}
Admīst^{rs} & assignes firmly by these p^rsents. & doth here-
unto sett his hand & Seale this 25^o day of March 1663.
