for the pursueing any forreigne Enemy th^t shall happen to
inuade the Prouince, as allso suppressing any insolencies or
mutinies committed by any Jndians abiding wthin the Prouince
contrary to such Articles agreed wth them.

Instructions from the hon^{ble} Charles Caluert Esq^r Gou^r to p. 187
Maio^r Samuel Goldsmith for the more speedy & effectuall
suppression of all mutinies, insolencies & insurrections, murthers
or plunders th^t may bee committed by any Indian or Jndians
whatsoeu^r

Yo^w are hereby impowred upon the inuasion or ap-
Jmp^r proach of any Jndians whatsoeu^r to any English Plantaōn
wthin yo^r Command to Leauy what forces in yo^r discretion
shall thinke conuenient for the resistance of any insolencies or
murthers by them committed, or may bee intended to be com-
mitted upon the p^rsons or Estates of any of the Jnhabitants
of this Prouince as afores^d

2^{ly} Yo^w are to impower such & such p^rsons as yo^w shall
thinke fitt wthin yo^r seuerall precincts to prosecute such Instruc-
tions as shall bee from time to time by yo^w to them directed.

3^{ly} That yo^w doe call to yo^r assistance the County Commis^{rs}
as time & opportunity shall requyre & permitt, to consult &
aduse upon what is expedient upon an urgent occasion to
bee done.

4^{ly} That yo^w forthwth send to the Sasquesahanough Jndians
to giue them notice th^t they immediately come downe to treat
wth yo^w, & the rest of the Commis^{rs} of this County aboute the
Articles of Peace lately confirmed by the Gou^r & Councell
together wth their consent. & easpecially strictly to insist upon
th^t Article (Viz^t) That they shall not approach any English
Plantaōn, but according to the tenor of that Article.
