yo<sup>w</sup> the s<sup>d</sup> Lieu<sup>t</sup> (W<sup>m</sup>) Coleburne in all things appteining to  
the comānd & Office hereby Conferred on yo<sup>w</sup> as they will  
answer the Contrary at their pills Given vnd<sup>r</sup> my hand &  
Seale this 26<sup>th</sup> day of March in the 32<sup>th</sup> year of his lo<sup>ps</sup> Do-  
minion ov<sup>r</sup> this Province Annoq Domini one Thowsand Six  
hund<sup>rd</sup> Sixty ffowre
