It was moued in Councell touching the Country howse. Whither if James Jolley refuse to p^rforme his Bargaine in repaying the s^d howse, according to his former promise made to the Gou^r & Councell: It bee not thought conuenient to Lett the s^d howse for certaine time of yeares to Will^m Smith for his better Encowragem^t hee putting in security to repayre the same in conuenient time to bee Limited by the Leiu^t Gräll.

Judged most fitt, requisite, & conuenient.

And then Ordcred th^t the s^d Will^m Smith find a Conuenient place or Chamber for the Clerks of the Court to Lodge in, in the s^d howse. And th^t 'till the howse, to putt the Records in, be quite finished, some Conuenient Roome or place bee likewise allowed & prouided for the Records to bee secured in, & the Clerks to write in.

Lastly th^t the whole Busines touching the same bee wholly left to the Leiu^t Grälls discretion, eyther as to Repaying the howse, or otherwise, as to him shall seeme Conuenient, in agreeing wth the s^d smith. Jf hee see cause therefore
