Charles Calvert Esq^r lieu^t & cheife govern^r of the pvinces of Maryland vnd^r the r^t hon^{ble} Caecilius lord & p^{pry} of the same To all psons to whom these pn^ts shall come greeting in o^r lord God Eu^rlasting Know ye th^t takeing into consid^racōn the petⁿ of divers psons well affected to this pvince now or late inhabitants of Northton County otherwise called Accomack in Virg^a who are desireous to transp^t th^mselves & families into this pvince & for the more speedy & effectual^l p^rsecucōn of his lo^{ps} Comānd to mee to see th^t pte of this pvince next adioyning to the County afores^d peop^ld & for the ease & benefitt of all such psons who shall Transp^t th^mselves into this pvince from Accomack afores^d I have nominated Constituted & impowred & do by these pn^ts Nominate Constitute & impow^r Step. Horsey, Cap^t W^m Thorne & W^m Bosman gen^{em} or any two of th^m being within this pvince to gr^t Warr^{ts} for land during the term of 6 months next ensueing the date hereof vpon the Eastern shore of this province in any pte between Choptanck river & a p. 198
