Horsey Capt W^m Thorne & W^m Bosman are hereby impowred to keep a book of all such Rts and Warrts as shalbe by thm or any of thm grantd distinctly reciting the name & Surname of eury pson for & in respect of whos transportacon they have allowed any land & the same at the end of the 6 months afors^d to return into the Secrtarys office signed with their hands & forasmuch in a place now peopld some differences may betweene pty & pty arise or Crimes be perpetrated & Comitted for the preservacion of the peace & better goverm^t of the people there resideing Wee doe hereby impow^r the s^d Step. Horsey Cap^t W^m Thorne & W^m Bosman or any too of th^m to heare & determine all causes not exceeding 2000 of Tob. as alsoe to cause to be apprhend & punished any Criminall offending agt any the laws of this province provided they proceed not to take life or memb^r Given att St Mary's vnder the lesser Seale of this province this 26th Day of May in the Two & thirtieth yeare of his lops Dominion ouer the said Province Annoq Domini one thousand six hundred sixty flowre.
