Ordred that the said Dan: Ienifer be paid Out of the publicque leauy for 2 mens hire and dyet w<sup>th</sup> other dis- } 940  
burism<sup>ts</sup> about the Office to the late Secretary }

Ordred that Leiutenn<sup>t</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Smyth be paid Out of the publicque leauy for Carpenters Work and Planck dis- } 3482  
burst about the Office to the late Secretary }

Then was read a petition of diuers Inhabitants & souldiers cf Charles County that the Governo<sup>r</sup> would displace Cap<sup>t</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Boreman whom was lately Constituted Cap<sup>t</sup> of the militia &c:

Ordred that the 5 first named in the said petition be sent for downe by speciall sumōns to the sherr. of that County, to appeare next Prouin<sup>all</sup> Court to Answer their Contempt herein for disobeying the said Com<sup>con</sup> their names are James Lindsey Joseph Harrison Ignatious Causine John Lewger and Thomas Allanson &c
