Att a Councell of the Rig<sup>t</sup> Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Proprietary p. 289 of this Prouince held att Mattapenny the 8<sup>th</sup> day of February in the 36<sup>th</sup> yeare of his said lordps Dominion Ouer this Prouince annoq Domini 1667—
