of the vpp^r house Desireing likewise the Assent of the vpp^r p. 32
house to the bill for Eleccōns, haveing layne soe long in the
vpper house since the Conference [at w^{ch}] time this house is
well Assured to have given suffi[cient Reasons] passing
Thereof
