Answer to the message about Jacob young [This house havin]g Taken the last Message Concerning Jacob young Into their Considera[tion doe] say that if the sayd Jacob Young wth the sayd securityes will stand Obleiged for his Immediate Transportacōn for Europe or be Confined to some Credible house in this County, for some reasonable time vntill he Cann Take shipping, Not Exceeding Two months, And that he shall not returne into this or any Other Neighbouring part of America, without the Consent of his Lordsp: and both houses of Assembly, Then this house is Content therewith and will Advance some Tobacco Towards the paym^t of his fees, if the vpper house will Concurr therein
